How To Get Your Own Members' Art Page @EuclidArt.com

EAA is offering members the opportunity to have their own Members' Art Page on EuclidArt.com. **THIS IS A PERK OF MEMBERSHIP.** There is no charge.

The page will be linked by your name and one image of your artwork. You have the opportunity to write a bio (with optional artist photo) of up to 190 words and to include 9 additional images of your artwork for a total of 10 images. You may include the name of the image, size of artwork, medium and price. You may include your contact information, like phone number and email address and you will be able to link to your existing website or Facebook, if you have them. You have the ability to change your page up to 3 times per year.

How do I get images of my Art to EAA's Website? We need good quality images of your artwork. You can photograph your own images using a digital camera or iPhone camera. Save the images in .jpg format and email the images as actual size to our webmaster, Jim Owens at gymfuzz@yahoo.com. Make sure you put EAA in the subject line of the email and only send 2 to 3 images at a time.

How do I get my bio to you and in what format? Bio is to be 190 words maximum presented in Word or PDF format. You are responsible for spelling and grammar. The files can be emailed to our webmaster at gymfuzz@yahoo.com. Indicate EAA in the subject line of your message. Include a photo of yourself in .jpg format for the bio page, optional.
