He is the leading magic marker artist in the country. Michael's art has been displayed in art shows, gallery shows, hospitals and private businesses around Northeast Ohio. A bit more information about Michael....he is a retired Chief Petty Officer in the United States Coast Guard Reserve. He served 22 years before he retired in 1994. He was a member of Port Security Unit 302, which was mobilized for Operation Desert Storm in 1990.
