

This workshop consists of a lecture, demonstration, and presentation of Dottie's approach to the portrait in black and white. Dottie received her BFA in Fine Arts from the Massachusetts College of Arts with a major in portrait painting. Having taught classes in the portrait from the

very basic to the more advanced, Dottie will present a clear and readily understandable approach for the students. Using charcoal as a medium, the portrait will be developed through basic theories and principles of shapes, forms, and values. After a complete understanding of the approach and applications of these theories the student will be given the opportunity to apply the learned material to the drawing of a portrait from a live model.
