ELIGIBILITY

Current paid members (July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025) of the Euclid Art Association.

ENTRY FEE

\$10.00 per artist, no refunds. Make checks payable to Euclid Art Association.

REGISTRATION

All entry forms with a non-refundable fee of \$10.00 must be received by **Thursday, June 12, 2025.**

ENTRY RULES

All pictures must be properly framed, wired and ready to hang. D-rings recommended. Gallery wrapped canvases with wires accepted. **No hanging hooks – wired only! No wet paintings! Size limit: no larger than 18” x 22” outside edge of frame.**

All work must be original and not previously displayed in any Euclid Art show. Artwork from the EAA virtual shows is eligible for this exhibit. Copies or photos of original paintings will not be accepted.

Entries must have two (2) labels. One identification label securely attached to the back of the picture; may use Scotch tape. Second label loosely attached to the front of the entry for easy removal; no Scotch tape on the front. The labels will include artist’s name, title, medium and price. This **MUST** match the info on your Entry Form. **NO CHANGES** can be made regarding price or title after entry forms are submitted.

Any work deemed objectionable to the integrity of the show will not be accepted. EAA reserves the right to use images of the entries for promotional purposes.

ENTRY LIMIT

Maximum two (2) works per artist.

ENTRY DELIVERY AND LOCATION

Entries must be taken to **The Heights Library Lee Road Art Gallery, 2340 Lee Road, Cleveland Heights, OH 44118, between 4:30 and 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 1.** Although all precautions will be taken in handling artwork, Heights Libraries and Euclid Art Association will not be responsible for damage or theft.

PICKUP

Thursday, July 31 from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. The Euclid Art Association and Heights Libraries will not be responsible for any artwork left after that time.

COMMISSION

The artist agrees to donate 10% of sales to the Friends of the Heights Libraries. All sales must be handled through the artist and take place outside of the library.

Euclid Art Association Art Show Categories:

Select a category for each work of art. Use the number of the category on your entry form.

1. **Oil/Acrylic:** Painting created using any oil or acrylic paint.
2. **Watercolor:** Paintings created with watercolor paint.
3. **Graphic Art:** Drawings using any dry medium, including pastels, ink or marker. Also includes fine art prints, calligraphy, and design for flat printed images.
4. **Mixed Media:** Art in which more than one art medium plays a significant role. Works of art in which the surface has been interrupted by cutting, pasting, attaching, or layering. (If a watercolor painting has a few pencil lines, or marker drawing has a few spots of paint, use the category of the obviously dominant medium rather than Mixed Media.)
5. **Photography:** Whether taken on film or digital format, works in this category capture something seen by the photographer. If changes are made to enhance dark & light, color, focus, etc. but the original subject is still intact, then the work belongs in this category, along with any image made in a darkroom.
6. **Digital Art:** Subjects from real life that are altered or combined to create an entirely new image, or any image created initially with a digital drawing or painting program.

Points to Remember:

Delivery and Pickup:

- If times are not convenient for you, plan with an art club buddy who may be available.

NO groups or sets for this exhibit.

A word about originality:

- Please submit only original artwork, done in the last 10 years. Entries should reflect not just your own hand, but your own idea for concept, content, and composition. **Theme: “Everything Magical”**

Hanging and display:

- Be sure two-dimensional work has a secure wire. D-rings recommended. No hanging hooks.
- No wet oil paintings. The painting **MUST** be completely dry.
- Crew will hang work to best display the whole show.
- Gallery wrapped canvases should have finished sides.

Responsibility:

- Artists need to be sure that framing/hanging/display devices are stable and secure and will withstand careful and necessary handling at the exhibit venue.

Notes about this venue: The Heights Library Lee Road Art Gallery

- **EAA is fortunate to have this space available for this themed exhibit.**
Size limit: no larger than 18” x 22” outside edges of frame.
- **The exhibition will be seen by library and Dobama Theatre patrons, including children.**
